


Natural Sciences Alumni Outcomes: 1996-2007

So far, sixty-nine percent of the Natural Sciences alumni have gone on to attend graduate or professional schools.

All of the alumni were employed or pursuing education at the time of completing the survey.


Graduate/Professional Education (N=16)

- Eight out of 11 alumni (73%) who attended graduate/professional schools received some type of


graduate financial support. **Graduate/Professional Schools Financial**




The Natural Sciences alumni were employed in a wide variety of fields.

Employment Fields (N=11)




Employment/Pursuing Education Status (N=16)

- **■** Pursuing Education


Of alumni who attended graduate/professional schools, 27% (3/11) earned advanced degrees so far. Nine degrees (82%) were in progress.
